*Lt. Jones explained the reports for the 5 years' (2019-2023) worth of cost comparison to patrol the 4<sup>th</sup> of July festivities. On average the cost is about twice what it would be on a normal payroll period. Talked about how it can burn an officer out when they are working 13-hour days with no days off. Corridon asked if the ECP asks for help from the Police Department or if they just assume it will happen. Chief Reese said it is their duty to help with the festivities. Chief Kleisch agrees the police presents at the park makes people feel safer and it discourages the fights/over drinking. Lt. Jones would like to narrow it down to 2-3 days instead of 4 days.*

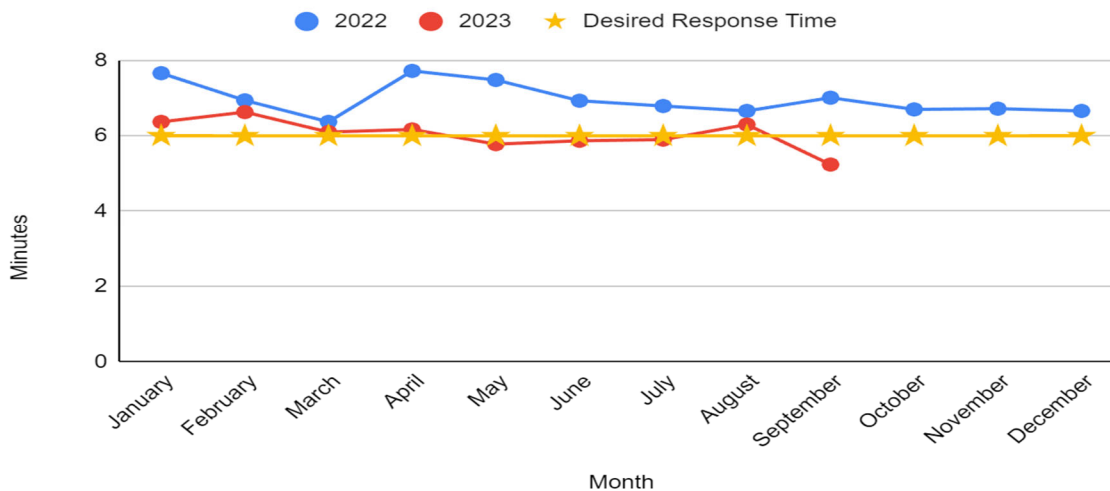
