On Thursday October 19th, 2017, at approximately 8:51 AM, Officers of the Evansville Police Department were summoned to 640 South 5th Street in the City of Evansville for a welfare check. Evansville police officers responded and arrived to find high school staff detaining an 18 year old former student of the Evansville School District.

The high school went on lockdown for brief period. The suspect was immediately taken into custody and was not in contact with any students.

The preliminary investigation indicates the suspect had responded to the high school to inflict harm on a member of the school staff.

The suspect is identified as:

Katelyn Nicole Frame, age 18 Evansville.

Frame was taken into custody on preliminary charges of:

- Disorderly Conduct While Armed
- 2nd Degree Recklessly Endangering Safety
- Possession of Dangerous Weapon on School Grounds

Frame was transported by the Evansville Police to the Rock County Jail.

The investigation remains open.
