On September 26, 2017, at approximately 10:02 a.m. the Evansville Police Department responded to a truck vs. pedestrian traffic crash at the intersection of West Main Street and North Fourth Street in the City of Evansville.

Preliminary investigation at the scene revealed that the truck was traveling West on West Main Street making a left turn to travel South on North Fourth Street and struck the pedestrian. The truck continued Southbound a short distance until it stopped just South of the intersection.

The driver of the truck was transported via ambulance to SSM Health St. Mary's Hospital – Janesville. The pedestrian was transported via ambulance to Mercy Hospital, Janesville and pronounced deceased upon arrival.

Rock County Sheriff's Deputies, the Wisconsin State Patrol Technical Reconstruction Unit, Janesville Fire and EMS, MD-1, Footville EMS, and Evansville Police, Fire and EMS responded to the crash scene.

Traffic at the intersection of West Main Street and North Fourth Street was closed around the intersection for approximately three and one-half hours until the scene was cleared. The crash remains under investigation.

The identity of the deceased will be released by the Rock County Medical Examiner's Office pending notification of the family.
