Sec. 122-132 Parking Restrictions in Public Parking Lots:

- (a) No Person shall park or leave standing any unoccupied vehicle in any public Parking lot in the city for more than 12 continuous hours on any calendar day. Merely moving the vehicle from one location to another within the same parking lot shall not interrupt the running of the 12-hour period.
- (b) No person shall park or leave standing an unoccupied vehicle in any parking lot in the city between the hours of 2:00am and 6:00am except in those areas designated for overnight parking by an annual or temporary residential parking permit and windshield sticker.
- (c) The Chief of Police shall issue parking lot residential parking permits and windshield Stickers pursuant to section 122-133 (Code 1986.S703(6))
Sec 122-133 Permit for Overnight Parking in Public Parking Lot.
- (a) Eligibility Issuance: Residents of the city may obtain from the Chief of Police a permit permitting overnight vehicle parking in designated areas of the city parking lots. Only one permit per residence of driving age shall be allowed. The applicant shall complete such form as required by the Chief of Police. The residence shall receive a sticker to be displayed on the vehicle windshield.
- (b) Temporary Permit: Temporary visitors to the city may obtain from the Chief of Police a temporary seven day parking permit permitting overnight vehicle parking in designated areas of the parking lots of the city. The applicant shall complete such form as required by the Chief of Police. The visitor shall receive a temporary permit and dashboard card to be displayed in the vehicle windshield.
- (c) Fee: There shall be a yearly fee, as established by the council from time to time by resolution and as set for in appendix A, for each calendar year or fraction thereof, for the annual residential parking permit. There shall be no fee for the temporary residential parking permit.
