Aquatic Center Assistant Director

The City of Evansville is accepting applications for the position of Aquatic Center Assistant Director. This is a seasonal position but will need some preparation and training prior to summer.

Applicants must have Lifeguard and First Aid certifications. APO/CPO, Water Safety Instructor, Life Guard Instructor and Food Service Manager certifications preferable. Applicants must also possess excellent customer service, problem solving and supervisory skills. Pay range is between \$12-\$14.28. Applicants will be expected to assist in the startup process throughout May part-time prior to opening day June 1<sup>st</sup> when the position will be part-time to full time until the pool closes in late August. Days and hours are flexible as to how supervisor coverage is scheduled based on the Aquatic Director's schedule and coordination with the other Assistant Director.
