City of Evansville Terrace Trees 2018

The City of Evansville is offering a limited number of terrace trees for sale to all City residents. The City Public Works Department and volunteers will plant, stake, and mulch the trees for the cost of \$55 per tree. Autumn Blaze and McSentry Linden trees are 1 1/4" in diameter, and the Discovery Elm and Donald Flowering Crab Apple trees are 1" in diameter. A site assessment will be required to insure the trees can be successfully planted. Tree planting will occur the weekend after April 27th, weather permitting.

Available trees include:

- McSentry Linden
- Autumn Blaze Maple
- Discovery Elm
- Honey Locust Imperial

Under a Power Line:

- Donald Whyman Flowering Crab apple

Supplies are limited so make purchase arrangements asap by please calling 882-2266, or stop at the Clerk's Office between the hours of 7:30am-4:30pm Monday thru Friday, or send an e-mail to leah.hurtley@ci.evansville.wi.gov. Orders will be taken until April 20th, or until this year's trees are gone. Tree selection is on a first come first serve basis. Payment must accompany order.
